

# How to enrol, update, or change rolls.

**Māori mā, if you're 18 or older and enrolling for the first time, you choose which roll to be on: the Māori roll or the general roll.**

You can choose to change the roll you're on for this year's local elections until **midnight 10 July**. The roll you choose may affect who you can vote for in these elections.

**Changing rolls, enrolling, or updating your details is easy!**



Go to **vote.nz** to do it online using your driver licence, passport or RealMe verified identity.

**Complete, sign, and return an enrolment form. You don't need ID to do this. You can submit it by uploading, emailing, or posting it back to us.**



Complete a form online and have it emailed or posted to you to sign and return.



Print and complete a form.
