You can enrol or update your details online at vote.nz
using your New Zealand driver licence, New Zealand
passport or RealMe verified identity. It takes about five
minutes and means you'll be ready to vote in this year's
General Election.

If you can't enrol online, you can enrol or update your details in other ways.

Download an enrolment form from our website

You can download a blank enrolment form from <u>vote.nz.</u> Print, complete, and sign your enrolment form. You can upload, email or post your completed form to us.

Enrol without ID

Complete an enrolment form online and have it emailed or posted for you to sign and return. Upload, email or post your completed form to us.



Update your details without ID

Complete an enrolment form online with your new details and have it emailed or posted for you to sign and return. Upload, email or post your completed form to us.

Call us to get an enrolment form in the mail

Call our 24-hour Freephone number 0800 36 76 56 to get an enrolment form sent to you in the mail. Complete and sign the form. Upload, email or post your completed form to us.

Freetext us to get an enrolment form in the mail
